Ecuador's RTV has taken season one of the DQ Entertainment and ZDF Enterprises co-production **The Jungle Book** (52 x 11'), seasons one and two of **Wicked Science** (52 x 26') produced by Jonathan M. Shiff Productions, FFC, Film Victoria, Network Ten, ZDF and ZDF Enterprises and also the movie (1X90'), as well as a renewal for the classic IMPS/Peyo property **The Smurfs** (163 X 26'), for Ecuador Free TV.

KM Services in Panama has scooped up timeless classic **The Smurfs** (52 x 26') and the adventures of **Lucky Fred** (52 x 12'), an Imira Entertainment co-production in conjunction with Televisió de Catalunya and RAI Fiction. .
